### Overview

### Results

#### Airport Matters

- Persuaded the California state court to reject a state constitutional challenge to landing fees at Santa Monica Municipal Airport.

- Convinced the California state court to reject a claim by the City of Ontario that its sale of Ontario International Airport to the City of Los Angeles was null and void.
- Litigated closely-watched, precedent-setting cases for airport owners, including leading antitrust and RICO cases in the First Circuit, an important preemption case in the Third Circuit and rate-setting appeals in the D.C. Circuit.
- Successfully defended numerous regulatory complaints at the FAA.
- Represented many large, medium and small hub airport in the negotiation and drafting of airport-airline use and lease agreements.
